Earlier this year, legendary luxury car maker **Aston Martin** teamed up with Dutch boat builder **Quintessence Yachts** and naval architects **Mulder Design**. Together they have produced a 37-foot (11-m) powerboat. Expectations are high for the first of these beautifully engineered and crafted boats to be available early next year, following massive interest in the designs revealed at **Monaco Yacht Show** this September.

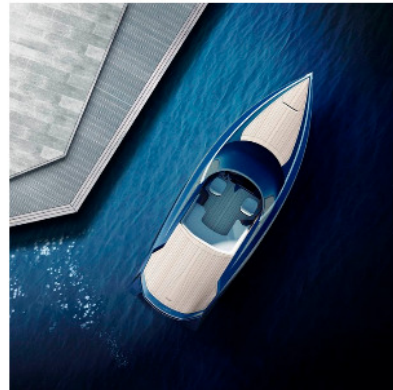
The powerboat has been designed around a new composite structure and will be available in two different versions – the AM37, and AM37 S. Digital images released recently by **Aston Martin** give an idea of the contours and design details to expect. Could one of these superb yachts be the ultimate Christmas gift? As yet prices have not been revealed.



The super sleek yacht has room for eight on board, and boasts a cabin crafted in sculpted wood and hand-stitched leather. There will be interactive voice control and activation along and an integrated HD touchscreen for navigation and multimedia system control.

In true Bond-esque fashion, potential owners of the new Aston Martin powerboat are being kept closely in the loop of the new project on a "strictly confidential one-to-one basis", further raising the sense of excitement among those who share an affinity with the Aston Martin marque and the yachting world.

Built for speed



According to Quintessence Yachts, the AM37 will be a classic 'gran turismo' leisure powerboat, capable of reaching top speeds of around 44 knots (50 mph/81 km/h).

The AM37 S will top out at 52 knots (60 mph/96 km/h), providing a full-on sports powerboat experience.

Mariella Mengozzi, chief executive of Quintessence Yachts, said the project has focused on translating Aston Martin's design language into an "innovative concept in the yachting world".

The yacht's carbon composite structure was created with the help of Dutch naval architects Mulder Design to ensure car-like comfort and performance.

In keeping with Aston Martin's British heritage, the boats are currently being made in Southampton, according to press reports.
